Region

Vietnam is located in Southeast Asia, just east of India on the greater Asian continent.

2

Area

Spanning 331,230 km², Vietnam is significantly smaller than India, which is about ten times larger.

Official Language

While India is multilingual, Vietnam's sole official language is Vietnamese.

4

Currency

The Vietnamese Dong (VND) currently exchanges at about 1 INR = 290 VND

Religion

Buddhism is the most widely practiced religion in Vietnam

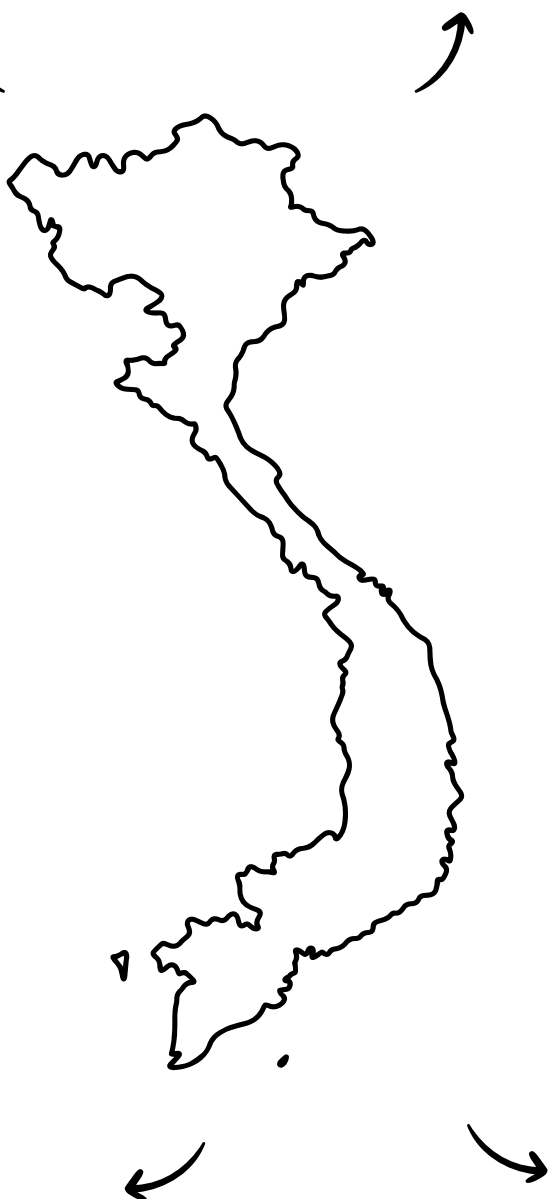

VISA AND PASSPORT

Passport Requirements

Your passport must be valid for at least six months from your planned entry date into Vietnam. Make sure it has at least two blank pages for visa stamps and entry/exit markings.

- Apply online for an E-Visa, allowing up to 90 days of stay.
- Straightforward process; visa usually issued in 3-5 working days.
- Customers can apply for an e-visa themselves for \$25 on the following website: <https://evisa.gov.vn/> or apply through Vietnamtour.in with an additional \$8 service fee.
- Visa exemption also applies if transiting through other Vietnamese airports and remaining in the transit area.

E-Visa

Visa Letter

- For longer stays, apply at the Vietnam Embassy or Consulate in India.
- Processing times vary, so apply well in advance.
- Some travel companies, like Vietnamtour.in, offer visa letter services to avoid visiting the embassy in person.

- Always carry a printed copy of your E-Visa or visa approval letter to present upon arrival.
- Ensure you provide accurate travel dates and personal information when applying to avoid delays or complications.
- Always check the latest regulations before planning your trip to Vietnam!

URGENT VISA ASSISTANCE

Below are the service fees for processing an urgent visa. Travelers will need to add an additional 25 USD for the visa stamp fee. Visitors can apply urgent visa through travel agency like Vietnamtour.in for timely assistance.

Wifi

Free Wi-Fi is widely available in hotels, cafes, restaurants, and even public areas. Speeds are generally fast, especially in cities like Hanoi, Ho Chi Minh City, and Da Nang.

Cost

A basic SIM card with several gigabytes of data can cost between 100,000 VND to 300,000 VND (approximately ₹300 to ₹900).

- You can purchase eSIM plans online
- Viettel, Vinaphone, and Mobifone offer various data packages ranging from 5 GB to 15 GB at prices between 100,000 VND (₹300) and 300,000 VND (₹900).
- Activation is quick and straightforward, typically involving scanning a QR code.

Call rates

- Local Calls: 500 VND per minute (₹1.70).
- International Calls: Around 10,000 - 15,000 VND per minute (₹35-₹55)

Dialing Codes

- To India: Dial +91 followed by the Indian phone number.
- To Vietnam: Dial +84 followed by the local Vietnamese number (omit the leading '0' in local numbers).

VIETNAM WEATHER

For Indian travelers, the best time to visit is from October to April, offering ideal weather across all regions.

Indian national festivals such as Diwali and Dussehra often fall in October or November, which is another popular time for Indian travelers to visit Vietnam. The weather during this time is cooler and more pleasant in most regions.



In the North

- Winter (Nov-Feb): Cool, sometimes cold (10°C-20°C). Best for trekking and cruising.
- Summer (May-Aug): Hot and rainy.
- Best time: Spring (Mar-Apr) and Autumn (Sep-Oct), with mild, pleasant weather.

In the Middle

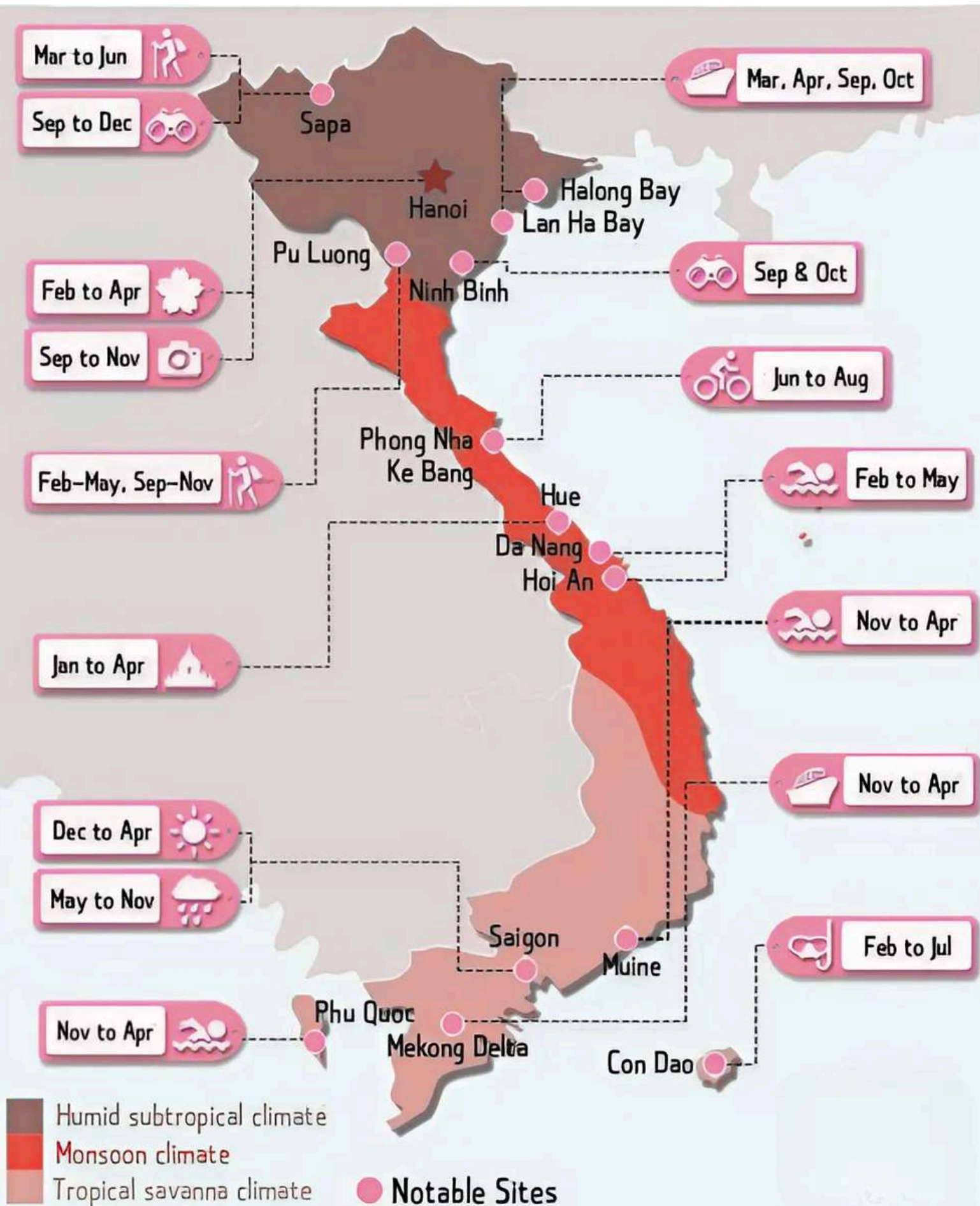
- Dry season (Feb-Aug): Hot and sunny, ideal for beaches.
- Wet season (Sep-Nov): Scattered heavy rain.
- Best time: Feb-Apr for mild temperatures and sunny skies.



In the South

- Dry season (Dec-Apr): Warm and pleasant (25°C-35°C).
- Rainy season (May-Nov): Short daily rains, but still hot.
- Best time: Dec-Mar for dry, sunny weather.

POPULAR VIETNAMESE DISHES

HALAL FOOD IN VIETNAM

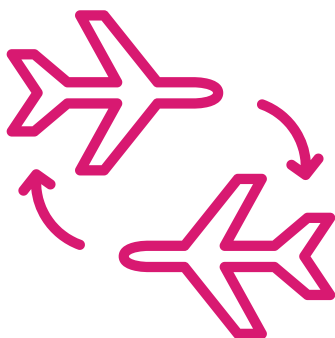

GETTING AROUND IN VIETNAM



Domestic Flights

Vietnam has a well-developed domestic flight network. Airlines like Vietnam Airlines, VietJet Air, and Bamboo Airways offer frequent flights.

Trains

The Reunification Express, which runs between Ho Chi Minh City and Hanoi, offers scenic views. Trains are comfortable and come in various classes.



Buses

Major cities and towns are connected by regular bus services, including Sinh Tourist, Mai Linh, and Futa Bus Lines. You can choose between sleeper buses or standard buses.

Taxis and Ride-Hailing Apps

Taxis are widely available in major cities. You can use ride-hailing apps like Grab, which is widely used in Vietnam.



Motorbike Rentals

Motorbike rentals are affordable, usually around 150,000 to 300,000 VND per day (approximately 500-1,000 INR). It's essential to have an international driver's license.

Cyclo (Rickshaw)

These rickshaws are popular in Hanoi and Ho Chi Minh City. The pace is slow, making them ideal for sightseeing. It is around 100,000-150,000 VND for a short ride.



Public Buses and Metro

Major cities like Hanoi and Ho Chi Minh City have extensive public bus networks, which are cheap and cover most parts of the cities. Apps like BusMap can assist with navigation.

MONEY AND PAYMENT



Conversion Rate

As of now, ₹1 (INR) is approximately 300-320 VND, but rates fluctuate. Always check before exchanging.

Currency Exchange

You can exchange INR to VND at major airports, banks, or authorized currency exchange counters in Vietnam. However, INR is not always readily accepted, so carrying USD or using ATMs might be more convenient.



Denominations of Vietnamese Dong

Vietnamese Dong comes in various denominations, primarily in banknotes:

- Smaller notes: 1,000 VND; 2,000 VND; 5,000 VND
- Mid-range notes: 10,000 VND; 20,000 VND; 50,000 VND
- Larger notes: 100,000 VND; 200,000 VND; 500,000 VND



ATMs & Cards

ATMs are widely available, and most accept international cards. You may want to inform your bank before traveling to avoid issues.

Cash

Vietnam is still largely cash-based, especially for smaller purchases, street food, and local markets. Always keep some VND handy.



TIPPING

Tipping is not mandatory but appreciated, especially in restaurants and for services.

SAFETY ISSUES

Water

- Stick to bottled or filtered water for safe consumption
- Bottled water is readily available at convenience stores
- Reliable water brands: Lavie, Vinh Hao, Evian, Vivant, Ion Li, Dasani

Food

- Well-cooked food: You should opt for well-cooked food, and be cautious when trying raw dishes.
- Fruits: Be cautious with fruits, especially those peeled or processed by local vendors. It's best to choose fruits from stores.

Health Risks and Diseases

- The most common health concerns in Vietnam are: Diarrhea; Malaria; Dengue Fever; Zika Virus.
- Take precautions such as drinking bottled or filtered water and using insect repellent.

Vaccination

- It is strongly recommended to be vaccinated against the following: Diphtheria; Hepatitis A and B; Japanese Encephalitis; Polio; TABT (Tetanus, Paratyphoid A and B, and Typhoid); Malaria (for certain regions)

Crime and Scams

- Keep your belongings secure and close to you.
- Avoid displaying expensive items in public.
- Always ask for the price before buying anything.
- Use trusted taxi services like Grab or Xanh SM to avoid being overcharged.

Travel Insurance

You can choose to purchase a policy from a provider in India or through a travel agency in Vietnam. A good travel insurance plan should cover:

- In-patient and Out-patient medical care
- Personal accidents
- Personal liability
- Loss of passport and/or International Driving Permit (IDP)
- Trip cancellations or delays
- Loss of check-in of luggage and personal belongings

Traffic Safety

- Unlike in India, Vietnam follows right-hand traffic.
- Be cautious and patient when crossing streets, and follow local traffic patterns.
- Always wear a helmet when riding a motorbike or as a passenger on a motorbike taxi.
- If you plan to ride a motorbike or yourself, ensure you have a valid motorbike license that is recognized in Vietnam and an International Driving Permit (IDP).

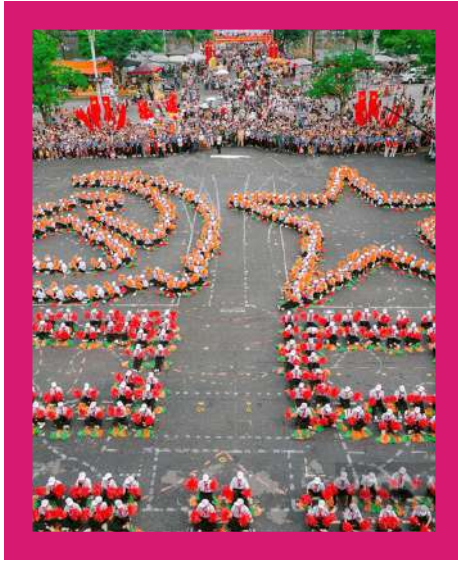

A key cultural practice where families maintain altars to honor deceased relatives with offerings of food, incense, and prayers, believing that ancestors continue to bless and watch over them.

Visiting Pagodas

Visiting pagodas is a common spiritual practice in Vietnam, where people pray for health, luck, and happiness. Pagodas are often visited during special occasions like Tet or before important events to seek blessings.

Marriage Customs

The ceremony usually includes an engagement party where the groom's family presents gifts to the bride's family, followed by a wedding with rituals like prayers at the ancestral altar.

Communal Dining

Involves sharing multiple dishes placed in the center of the table, with everyone serving themselves. It fosters a sense of togetherness, respect for elders, and social connection during meals.

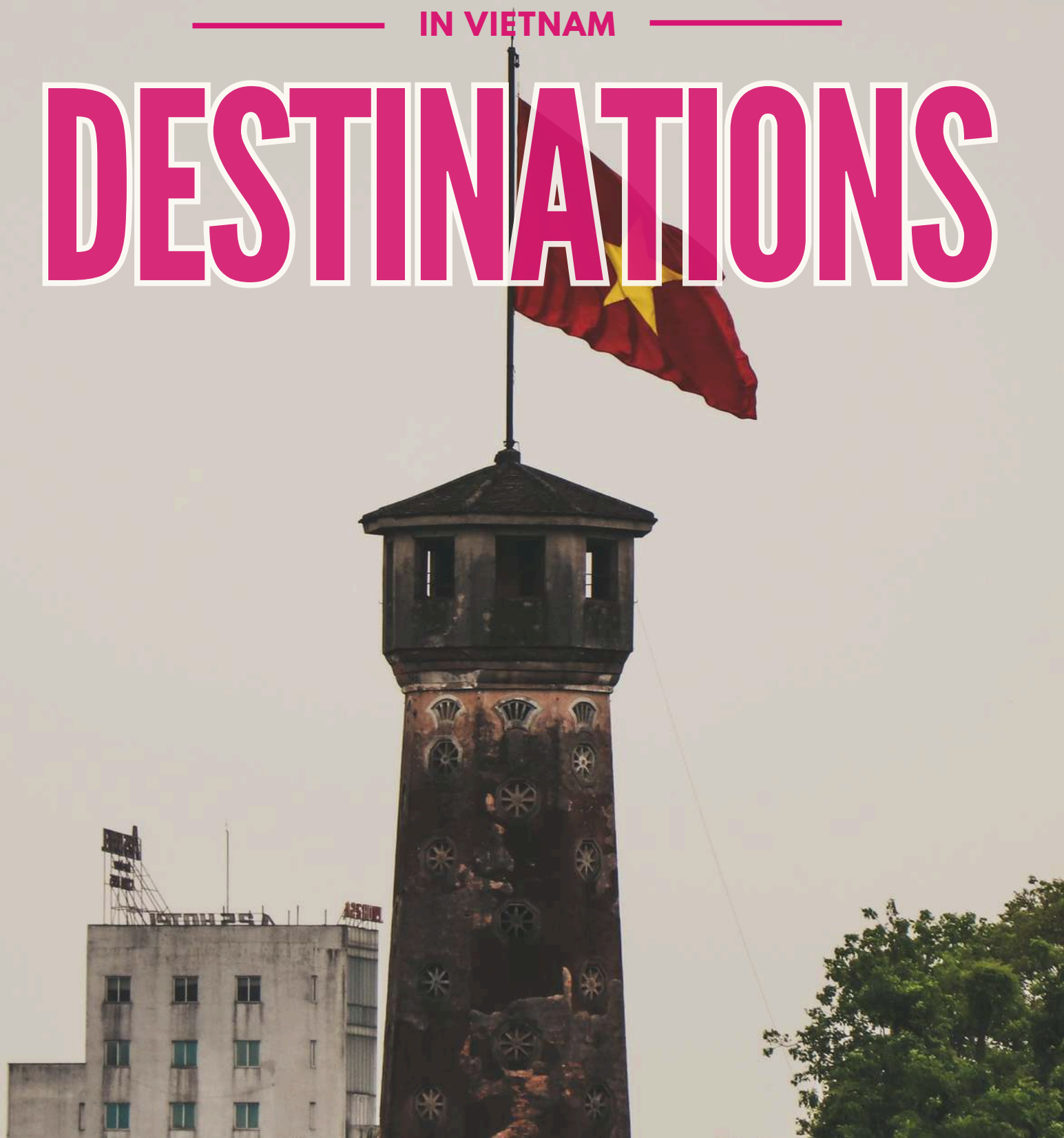
Respect for Elders
